- (6) Reason of Categorization  
The project falls into large-scale oil and gas sector under the Environmental Guidelines.
- (7) Environmental Permission/Approval by the Environmental Authority  
The Environmental Impact Assessment report has been developed based on the relevant laws in Mexico and approved by the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources (SEMARNAT).
- (8) Anti-Pollution Measures
