- (6) Reason of Categorization
The project is not located in a sensitive area, nor has it sensitive characteristics under the Environmental Guidelines, and its potential adverse impacts on the environment are not likely to be significant.
- (7) Environmental Permission/Approval by the Environmental Authority
The environmental impact assessment has been approved and the permission on construction waste soil (dredged sand) disposal has been issued by Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (MONRE) on July 30th, 2007.
- (8) Anti-Pollution Measures
The planned values for air quality, water quality and noise levels on the whole below/within the local standards and the international standards.
- (9) Natural Environmental Considerations
It is the project within the existing port complex, with no nature reserves in the premises.

(10) Social Considerations

There is neither impact on cultural heritage, nor on the landscape. And no resettlement will be required since it is a project in the existing port complex.

(11) Monitoring

Monitoring of air, water, solid-waste and sedimentation will be conducted and reported periodically to relevant authorities as well as MONRE.
