 The project falls into the large-scale oil refinery sector under the Environmental Guidelines.
- (7) Environmental Permission / Approval by the Environmental Authority
 The Environmental Impact Assessment was made under the relevant
 environmental regulations of Egypt, and approved by the Environmental
 Authority of Egypt in April 2009.
- (8) Anti-Pollution Measures

The planned values for air quality, discharged water quality and noise levels meet the local and international standards. Other wastes are to be appropriately treated under the local standards.

Though soil contamination was observed in the project site, it has been confirmed that such contamination was not caused by the Project. The Project will develop a voluntary soil remediation plan to execute soil remediation within the project site following consultation with the environment agency.

(9) Natural Environmental considerations

The project site and adjacent areas have been designated as an industrial area, and there are no protected areas designated under the local regulations or international treaties.

It has been confirmed that there are no precious species designated by the local regulations and international standards in the project site and the surrounding area.

(10) Social Consideration

The implementation of the Project entails resettlement of refinery employees and their families, which is properly handled by the project sponsor based on the local regulations. The resettlement plan has been agreed by all the residents being relocated and no grievance has been reported.

(11) Monitoring

Environmental monitoring for air, water, noise, waste, chemicals and others will be implemented based on the local regulations.
