- (6) Reason of Categorization
The project falls into the large-scale thermal power sector and is located in a sensitive area under the Environmental Guidelines.
- (7) Environmental Permission/Approval by the Environmental Authority
The EIA Report of power plant, transmission lines and substation has been developed in accordance with Chilean laws and regulations, and approved by the Environmental Authorities.
- (8) Anti-Pollution Measures
Appropriate measures will be taken regarding air quality, water quality, and noise to meet Chilean and international standards. Other pollution prevention measures will also be taken in an appropriate manner.
- (9) Natural Environmental Considerations
The project does not include any protected area designated under the national law or

international conventions. Although there is breeding ground of birds which have been designated as endangered species under Chilean laws around the project site, the project proponent will take mitigation measures such as scheduling construction and equipment measures. In addition, the project proponent will monitor the protection of such species and take the additional measures, if needed.
