**ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (EIA) APPROVAL FOR THE PROPOSED SAGAMU LDZ NATURAL GAS PIPELINE NETWORK CONSTRUCTION PROJECT AT IBEFUN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA, OGUN STATE.**

Please refer to your letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 requesting for an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) permit for the above project.

2. Following the successful conclusion of the evaluation of the project's Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), I am directed to convey the Ministry's **EIA Approval** for the development of a 12" X 135km pipeline network from KP312 tie-in point of the Escravos Lagos Pipeline System at Ibefun to Rite Foods Nigeria Limited in Ososa, Ijebu Ode Local Government Area, Ogun State with the following conditions:
  - a. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall implement energy-efficient measures in line with the stipulations of Nigeria's Nationally Determined Contributions (NDC) to the "Paris Agreement" within the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
  - b. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall develop and implement Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Plan for the project.
  - c. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall ensure that all roads, rails and creeks/rivers crossing are carried out through horizontal direct drilling/thrust-boring with casing and not less than 1.2meters below ground level.
  - d. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall fully implement the Waste Management Plan for the project.
  - e. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall put in place a robust Occupational Health and Safety Management Plan as well as Emergency Response and Contingency Plans for the project.
  - f. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the project's host communities and other relevant stakeholders.
  - g. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall ensure continuous consultations with the project's host communities, relevant stakeholders and other regulatory authorities throughout the project's lifespan.

**Continuation.**

- h. Transit Gas Nigeria Limited shall fully implement the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) for the project.
  - i. The Federal Ministry of Environment (FMEnv) in collaboration with other relevant regulatory authorities shall carry out EIA Impact Mitigation Monitoring (IMM), Environmental Audits (EAu) and Compliance Monitoring exercises on the project.
  - j. There shall be an Environmental Management System (EMS) for the project.
3. The Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Certificate for the project shall be issued in due course.
